Focusing on the basic skills and info needed to improve results in competition obedience and rally as well as some of the advanced obedience skills.

Credentials - June has personally trained and shown 21 different dogs to a CD. (11 Borzoi, 4 Weims, 2 Labs, 1 Whippet, 1 German Shepherd, 1 Husky/Aussie mix, and 1 Pom). 13 earned their CDX, 6 earned UDs, 2 UDXs, and 1 an OTCH. In addition to winning many Specialty and Natl Specialty High In Trials, she won *all breed* High In Trials with 4 different Borzoi, 1 Weim, 1 Lab, and her Pom. She won Dog World Awards (finishing title in first 3 trials, all with scores of 195 or above) on 3 Borzoi, 1 Weim, and the Pom. No perfect scores, but she has 199s on 3 different Borzoi and the Pom, plus another Borzoi had a 199 1/2 once.

June's philosophy - **"My dogs are my pets first. I train what I have. My own personal goal is a qualifying performance with reasonable accuracy and a decent attitude. *If I can be successful at obedience, SO CAN YOU!*"**

June has taught obedience classes to the general public since the early 1980s.

What will be covered? This is a working seminar. It's for newcomers to the sport *as well as* those already competing (esp in the lower levels) who want to improve their performance. Some advanced obed exercises will be covered. The *focus is on the basic skills* with demonstrations, run throughs, and problem solving. Training, rules, ring etiquette, and handling will be covered.
